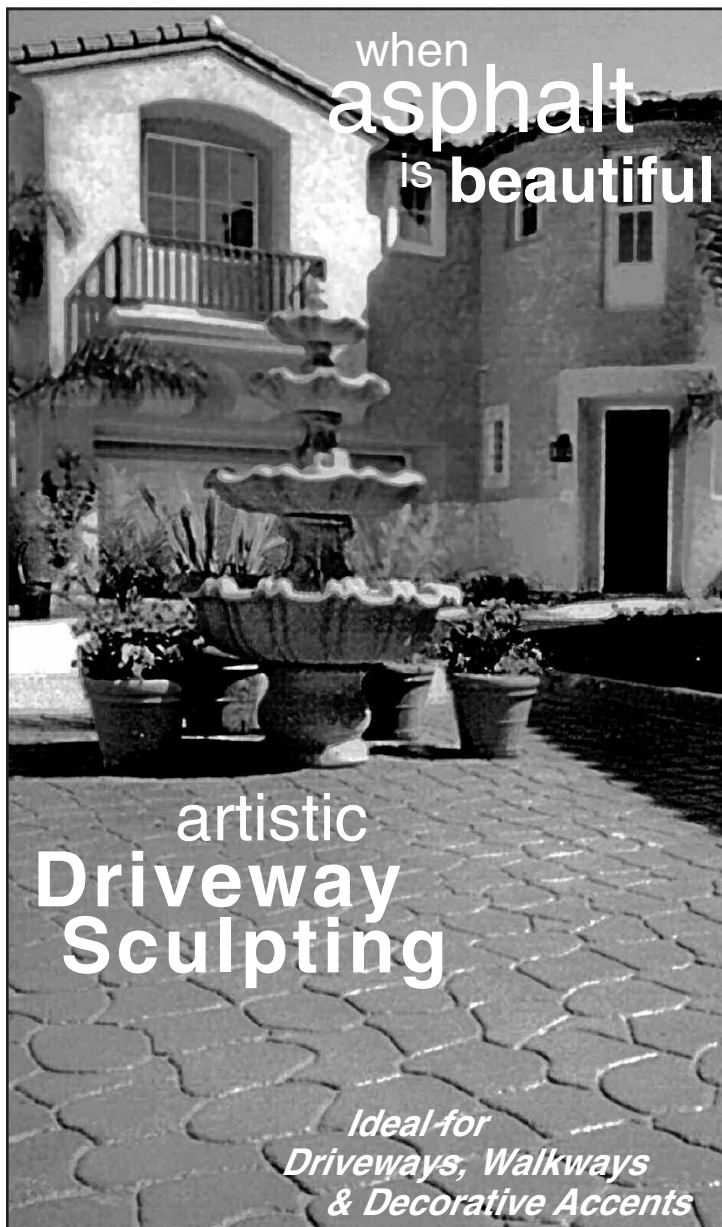

HINSDALE FAMILY SUPPORTS PROJECT

The Christopher Family Foundation of Hinsdale has given \$1.5 million to the Chicago Zoological Society, which manages Brookfield Zoo.

The donation will go toward the renovation of the zoo's old Reptile House into a conservation learning center.

"Our support of Brookfield Zoo is in response to the outstanding programs that our family has had the opportunity to enjoy over the years. Today, the third generation of children in our family visit Brookfield Zoo to delight in all that it offers. Our gift will help to assure that such excellent programs will continue into the future," Doris Christopher said.

Doris and Jay Christopher and Kelley Schueler, executive director of The Christopher Family Foundation, presented the donation to Stuart Strahl, chief executive officer and president of the zoological society, and Michael Emmert, treasurer of the society's board of trustees, April 15.

The gift will fund the construction of The Christopher Family Education Wing of the new center, which will feature four classrooms. One of the classrooms located in the center atrium will be able to be converted into an exhibit hall for temporary traveling displays that will be open to zoo guests.

The remaining portion of the renovated building will house staff members of the zoological society's Center for Conservation Leadership. The entire project is estimated to cost \$3.5 million.

SNOWBOARDER RANKS EIGHTH

Colin Kendall of Hinsdale finished eighth of about 60 riders in the 10-12 age group in the halfpipe competition earlier this month at the U.S. Amateur Snowboard Association national championships in Copper Mountain, Colo. That puts him in the top 10 of all snowboard halfpipe riders his age in the country.

Kendall, 12, also placed 10th in slopestyle.

Last year he placed 31st out of 50 in halfpipe and 36th out of 60 in slopestyle.

DOCTOR APPOINTED TO COMMISSION

Dr. James Hannigan of Hinsdale, an oncologist who treats patients at Adventist La Grange Memorial Hospital, has been appointed cancer liaison physician for the hospital's cancer program. Cancer liaison physicians are an integral part of cancer programs accredited by the American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer. It is a three-year appointment.

Hannigan is among a national network of more than 1,600 volunteer physicians who are responsible for providing leadership and direction to establish, maintain and support their facilities' cancer program. Hannigan, who has a significant interest in the diagnosis and treatment of patients with malignant diseases, is a member of the multidisciplinary cancer committee at the hospital and serves as secretary/treasurer of the hospital's medical staff.

HINSDALE WOMAN LEADS COMPANY

Kathleen Benner of Hinsdale will serve as president of Hospital Companions Inc., a new company that launched April 13.

Hospital Companions aids patients and families during a hospitalization by providing non-medical companionship and enhanced communication services. Patients have a companion at their bedside who will serve as a health advocate with medical staff and who will develop a Web accessible patient page for family and friends to visit for updates.

The company's mission is to enhance the patient care experience through an extensive support program.

"Our goal is to make some of life's most difficult moments easier for our patients and their families" Benner said.
